We thank God for His provision and the means that He provides to engage in His ministry through Weston Park.

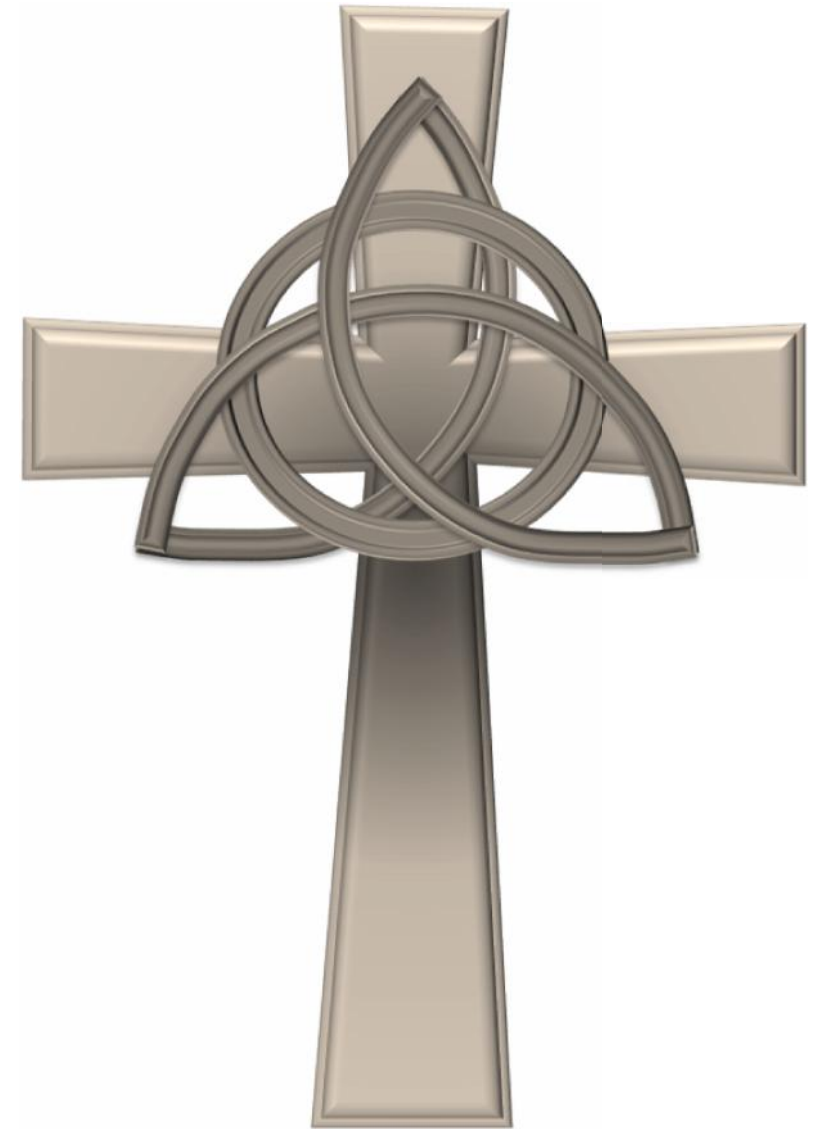
Weekly Givings ...
