

- The beatitudes (Matthew 5:3-12) define the vision of the new faith community
- » A colony of heaven in the midst of an alien culture
- Peacemakers in a troubled world



- The church is often overlooked or dismissed as irrelevant
- > We are a small group attempting to live out an alternative life
- How can we be faithful in our calling to represent Christ to a troubled world?



You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything, but is thrown out and trampled under foot.

Matthew 5:13

THE SALT OF THE EARTH

- a bit of salt flavours the whole
- > Salt also acts as a preservative
- > If salt loses its saltiness it has no value
- > Aramaic: Salt = wisdom

NOT STATUS BUT FUNCTION

The 'you' is plural - speaks to our corporate nature to have influence in the community - the faith community is to make a difference being salty is not for ourselves but others

You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hidden. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house.

Matthew 5:14-15

THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

- As a light the church acts as an attraction, a guide, a sign, a warning of danger
- > Think of a Lighthouse shining the way home

VISIBLE NOT HIDDEN

- The light is put on a lampstand to illuminate the entire house
- You are the light' is plural referring to a corporate entity
- > Also individual lights shining for Jesus (Philippians 2:15)



In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your father in heaven.

Matthew 5:16

CHRIST'S LIGHT

- We reflect the light of Christ who is the 'light of the world' (John 8:12; 9:5)
- We shine, not our own light, but Christ's - as the moon reflects the light of the sun

For it is the God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness', who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:6

LIKE LAMPSTANDS

- We (the church) are to shine like lampstands giving light to the region where we live - Revelation 2+3
- It is not a competition we merely shine as lights for Jesus



i. IT COUNTS

What the church does really counts - the faith community flavours and enlightens the world around it

ii. ITS KINGDOM LIVING

The church (and us as participants) have a purpose/mission to live out the kingdom of God

- Our lives mean something, we have a story to tell
- It matters that we exist and live our lives for Jesus

iii. IT REQUIRES FOCUS

The caution is given that we not become side-tracked with secondary concerns
- Lose our saltiness, hide our light under a bushel

We are to stay focused on what really matters

 Our purpose is not to simply live comfortable and self-centred lives

iv. GOD WILL BE GLORIFIED

We are to be salt and light for others so that God is glorified

so that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, in which you shine like stars in the world.

Philippians 2:15

Tyndale Chapel – Light comes
 through the stained glass and a
 rainbow of colours shine
 - so we express the light of Christ
 in a rainbow of expressions

v. GOD'S CHARACTER REVEALED As we 'shine/flavour' - so God is seen as our loving, caring, Parent (v16b)

'Abba' - this is the first time
 Jesus uses this, his favourite
 word for God - a caring parent

Our interpersonal relationships communicate the loving nature of God.
